Forest Garden

A forest garden has been in the making for 12 years in the northwestern part of Slovenia. The owner creates a forest garden for food self-supply. The soil is very poor and holds water poorly, so the owner built ponds that he uses for watering. The ponds enabled the development of animal species in the surrounding area. The biotic diversity of animals has increased.

The owner of the forest Garden planted fruit trees in the forest garden apple, pear, cherry, sour cherry, plum and walnut trees, which were to be a key part of the garden in the following decades. He also planted some useful types of perennials - peppermint, Jerusalem artichoke, lemon balm and comfrey. He planted clover and lupins to add nitrogen.

- Mountain pasture is an important part of Slovenian sustainable farming, which occurs from the NW to the NE part of Slovenia (Alps area).
- In this way, pasture areas at higher altitudes are preserved, overgrowth is prevented, hilly parts are cheaply maintained, and livestock cattle, small animals and even horses spend a good part of the year in nature, where their well-being is best taken care of.

Pohorska planja

- Sheep were raised in Pohorje (NE part of Slovenia) as early as the 15th century. Livestock were initially pastured on forest pastures, but later they were cut down. Over time, the meadow ecosystem developed, grasslands - known as Pohorska planja were created. Today, the characteristic landscape of Pohorje is a mix of forest and grasslands, where cattle still pasture.

Mejice

- Mejica is a compact line of woody vegetation (trees or shrubs) at least 10 meters long and at most 20 meters wide. The species differ between regions, but in most cases species such as blackberry, rosehip, blackthorn, hazel, black elder, hawthorn, red dogwood, oak, elm, maple, ash grow in mejica.

Mejice

Mejica are a habitat that is a rich source of food for birds, bees and other wild animals, they are a refuge for agricultural beneficial birds and insects (pollination, biological control of pests - birds and predatory insects), they reduce the leaching of nutrients and residues of phytopharmaceuticals into groundwater, reduce the negative impacts of climate change (carbon storage), are a renewable energy source as they provide firewood, reduce the carbon footprint, offer protection to pasturing animals from heat and rain, discourage wild animals (deer, wild pigs) from agricultural land...

Steljniki

Steljniki are agricultural areas are overgrown with rare birch forest, red pine, eagle fern and foxglove, which are pastured or mowed regularly, at least once a year. The fern is dried and used as bedding for cattle, horses and other farm animals. There are also various mushrooms, butterflies, insects, orchids and other animals. Litter and other plants usually cover more than 80% of the ground. Trees with crowns cover less than 75% of the area. Steljniki are listed in Natura 2000 as a natural heritage and are protected. They are typical of the Bela krajina in SE Slovenia.

Hazelnuts in the home garden


